

**C-13.0 RECOMMENDED PROGRAM CHANGES**

**C-13.1 Introduction**

The assessment of stormwater program effectiveness assessment, which is discussed in **Section 1.0** is conducted at two levels. At the jurisdictional or Permittee level, the assessment is conducted annually and focuses on program implementation. Inferences about the connection of management program elements to water quality improvements made in these assessments will predominantly be drawn from the assessment of programmatic indicators and indirect measures of progress. Further, the outcome of the assessment will be proposed revisions to the LIP. The Permittees' assessments are presented as Exhibits to this report.

At the countywide program level, the major assessment is done principally on a five yearly basis with an emphasis on using direct measures of progress. This assessment is targeted at informing the review and revision of the DAMP using information from the water quality monitoring program. There are no proposed revisions to the DAMP.
