Tsunami Preparedness and Alert OC

AlertOC is a mass notification system designed to keep residents and businesses informed of emergencies and certain community events.

By registering with AlertOC, time-sensitive voice messages from the County, City of Dana Point and/or City in which you live or work may be sent to your home, cell or business phone. Text messages may also be sent to cell phones, e-mail accounts and hearing impaired receiving devices.

Alert OC will be one of the main notification systems used during an event such as a Tsunami. Alert OC will notify local and out of the area boaters of Harbor related Tsunami instructions. If you keep a boat in the Dana Point Harbor, it is important to sign up for this free service. When you do, please include Dana Point Notifications as one of your notification requests.

AlertOC is a joint County/City program.
