What is the Orange County Mental Health Board (MHB)?

Under state law, the MHB is required to review and evaluate mental health needs, services, and special projects in the Orange County mental health system. These requirements also include advising the Orange County Board of Supervisors and Behavioral Health Director as to any aspect of the local mental health programs

Volunteer Requirements include:

- Members must be available to attend two (2) monthly meetings, on the 2nd Tuesday, 9:00 am – 10:30 am and the 4th Wednesday, 9:00 am – 10:30 am.
- Members must reside in the Orange County
- Members may not work for the County or a contracted agency/provider of Behavioral Health Services
- Members must be a direct consumer of mental health services, family member, mental health professional, or have public interest in County mental health services
