Hepatitis A is a virus that causes serious liver infection and can easily spread from person to person. This virus can make you sick for weeks to months.


How is Hepatitis A spread?



An infected person not washing hands after using the bathroom




Eating or drinking food contaminated with Hepatitis A

What are the symptoms of Hepatitis A?



Fever



Jaundice (Skin or eyes look yellow)



Dark pee, pale poop, or diarrhea

If you think you have Hepatitis A, go to your doctor or the emergency room.

How can you prevent Hepatitis A?



Get vaccinated for Hepatitis A



Always wash your hands, especially
- before eating or making food
- after using the bathroom
