

**Reinstatement of an Expired California EMT Certificate**

*(California Code of Regulations Title 22 Section 100081)*

**The following table provides guidance for reinstatement of a California EMT Certification that has lapsed/expired.**

(completing greater than 12 hours in a single day will not be accepted)</li> <li>- Acceptable college course work with a “C” or better grade in each course</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Provide a completed copy of the most current CA EMT Skills Competency Verification Form (EMSA – SCV)</li> <li>• Provide copy of previously issued CA EMT card</li> <li>• Criminal History/DOJ <b>if you were not previously certified with OCEMS</b></li> </ul> <p><b>AND</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete an <b>additional 24 hours of CE</b> for a <b>total of 48hrs of CE’s</b></li> <li>• <b>Complete a new Background check</b></li> </ul> <p><b>AND</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pass the <b>NREMT written and skills certification exams within two (2) years</b> of application date (unless possess current and valid EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic NREMT Certificate/Card <b>OR</b> current and valid California AEMT Certificate or Paramedic License).</li> <li>• Complete application &amp; pay the fee</li> </ul>
