



## Gilbert Street Improvement Project

Construction will include lane closures



### What improvements are being performed?

The project is designed to improve safety along Gilbert Street and span approximately 5,600 feet.

**Lane closures:** During construction period, traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction in order to complete the street improvements as quickly and safely as possible.

**Please allow extra time** for your drive in/near this street improvement area.

<b>Improvements include:</b>	Pavement rehabilitation	Traffic signs
	Traffic signal replacement	Striping
	Pavement markings	Completing sidewalk, driveway approaches, intersections and curb ramps compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
	Left-turn pockets at intersections	



### When will the work occur?

**Approximate project schedule:** From June 22, 2015 to early February 2016  
**Days:** Mon — Fri **Hours:** 8:30 am — 3:30 pm

**Note:** This schedule is tentative and could change due to weather or other factors. Work during extended hours and/or on Saturdays may occur as needed.



### Where will the improvements be performed?

**Along Gilbert Street:**

From approximately 300 feet south of Katella Avenue to Ball Road in unincorporated County area adjacent to the cities of Anaheim, Stanton and Garden Grove. **See project area map on opposite side.**
