



Serrano Creek Channel Rehabilitation Project



Project Summary

OC Public Works will complete routine rehabilitation work within the Serrano Creek Flood Control Channel, located in the Cities of Irvine and Lake Forest. All construction activity will take place within the flood control channel between the intersection of Alton Parkway and Muirlands Boulevard and Trabuco Road. Businesses, parks and trails located within close proximity to the construction area may experience an increase in construction-related noise and dust during working hours.

WHAT

Rehabilitation work includes removing silt, repairing concrete, reestablishing the “rip-rap” and removing and replacing chain link fencing. OC Public Works contractors and staff will access the channel through the Etnies Skate Park entrance to complete the portion of the work adjacent to the Park. Flag personnel will be onsite to direct traffic and to ensure safety as necessary.

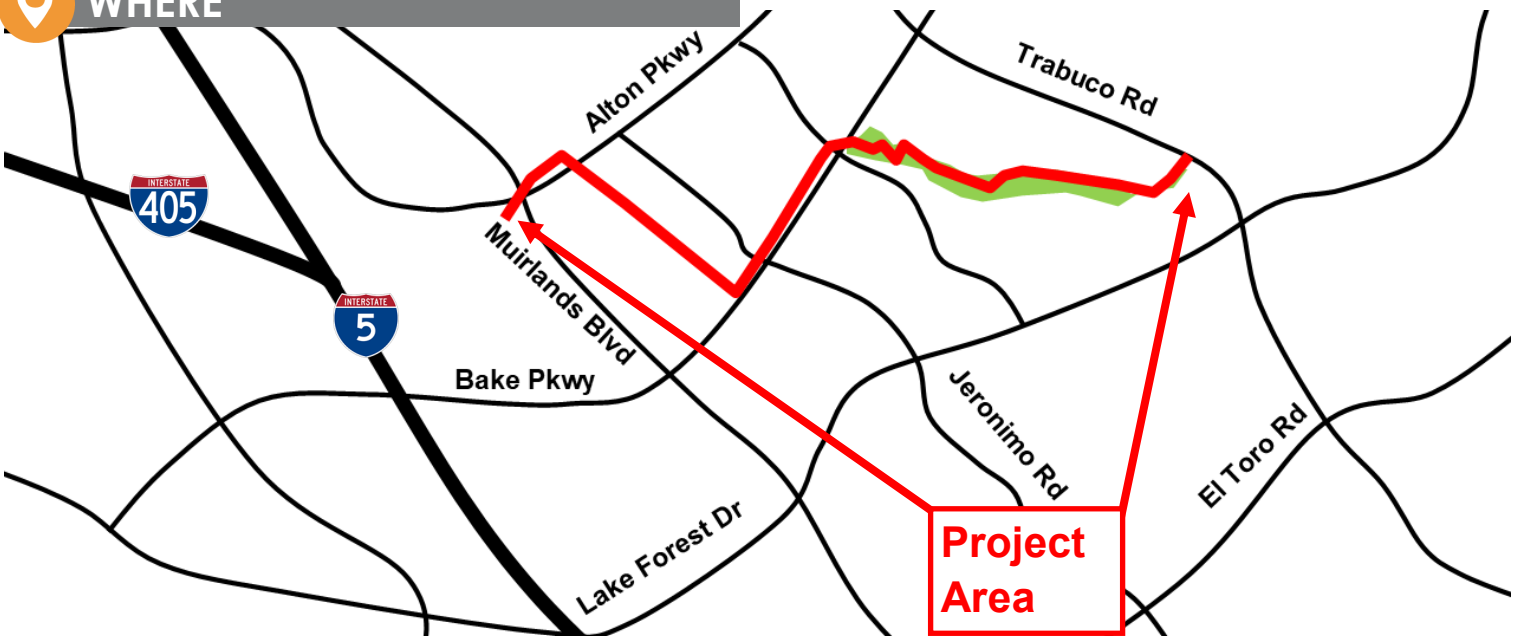
