

Peters Canyon Channel Vegetation and Sediment Removal



Project Summary

OC Public Works will remove vegetation and sediment build-up within the Peters Canyon Channel from Interstate 5 to south of Walnut Avenue within the City of Irvine. **Roads located within the project area will remain open at all times during construction; however, lane closures may be required. Area motorists and other road users may experience delays when travelling through the project area. Traffic control measures, such as flag personnel and signs, will be present.** The adjacent Peters Canyon Regional Bikeway will remain open at all times; however, periodic closures of the adjacent hiking and riding trail are expected. Detours will be present and signage will be posted near the project area.

WHAT

Construction activity will include removing vegetation and sediment from the channel and regrading the channel invert. A vegetated buffer area will remain to allow wetland plant species to establish.
