

Wagon Wheel Creek Emergency Repair Project



Project Summary

During a recent storm event, portions of the existing wooden panels adjacent to Wagon Wheel Creek were damaged. OC Public Works will make emergency repairs to the damaged panels and reinforce the structure to mitigate further damage. **A two-month trail closure will be required. Trail users will be detoured around the project area and onto the sidewalk along Oso Parkway. The trail closure is approximately 600 feet in length and is located across from Wagon Wheel School Road.** This project is being completed by OC Public Works on behalf of OC Parks.

WHAT

OC Public Works will construct riprap walls in front of the damaged panels as a temporary security measure. Washed out areas beneath the wooden panels will be filled with additional soil to mitigate erosion and additional soil will be placed on top of the riprap walls.
