Temporary Evacuation Points (TEP) in Orange County

- ❖ The American Red Cross has set up TEP's at the listed location in Orange County in order to provide assistance for those individuals affected by this morning's severe storm front. The Temporary Evacuation Point is a place where residents can get information and resources to assist in any relocation needs. Residents are asked to stay in their vehicle and wait for assistance.
- ❖ Animals **will not** be allowed in these shelters (except service animals).
- ❖ Bring your medications if possible.
- ❖ Keeping COVID-19 precautions in mind, residents who have evacuated are encouraged to look for alternative accommodations, such as family, friends or hotels
- ❖ El Toro HS is open all night as a resource center only
