## **Andrew Do Elected Chairman of OC Board of Supervisors, Doug Chaffee as Vice Chairman**

*March 9<sup>th</sup> Special Election Set for 2<sup>nd</sup> District Vacancy*

**Santa Ana, Calif.** (January 22, 2021) – Supervisor Andrew Do has been chosen unanimously by his Board colleagues to serve as Chairman of the Orange County Board of Supervisors for 2021. Supervisor Doug Chaffee, Fourth District, will serve as the Board’s Vice Chairman.

Re-elected as First District Supervisor in November 2020 and sworn in for his new term on January 12, 2021, Chairman Do represents the communities of Santa Ana, Garden Grove, Westminster, Fountain Valley, and Midway City.

“By setting aside our ideological differences and embracing a greater sense of community engagement, we have responded to the COVID-19 pandemic, expanded access to mental health care, and improved our delivery of homeless services, while protecting our community,” said Chairman Do. “I look forward to working closely with Vice Chairman Doug Chaffee and my colleagues as we continue this momentum into 2021.”

Chairman Do’s 30-year career at the County of Orange has included service as a Public Defender, District Attorney, and previously served as a chief of staff on the Orange County Board of Supervisors. He attended the University of California at Davis for his undergraduate degree and the University of California, Hastings College of the Law.

### **Supervisor Doug Chaffee Elected Vice Chairman**

Supervisor Chaffee was chosen by his fellow board colleagues to be Vice Chairman this year. He represents the residents of the Fourth District – which includes the cities of Brea, Fullerton, La Habra, Placentia, portions of Anaheim, portions of Buena Park, and unincorporated areas. Prior to serving on the Board of Supervisors, Supervisor Chaffee was elected to the Fullerton City Council in 2012 and was re-elected in 2014. He served as Mayor of Fullerton in 2017-2018 and 2013-2014 and as Mayor Pro-Tem in 2016-2017 and 2012-2013.

“I look forward to working in partnership with Chairman Do and our colleagues on the Board of Supervisors to provide quality healthcare and win our battle against the COVID-19 virus, so we may achieve economic recovery for the benefit of our Orange County residents. We want to

## **March 9, 2021: Special Election Set to Fill 2<sup>nd</sup> District Vacancy**
