

**Clients' Profiles Fact Sheet
Seniors Served by SSA**



Orange County has a population of 495,151 seniors age 65 and older*. The population increased by 11.9% from FY 2015-16 to FY 2018-19, and a further increase of 12.6% is projected from FY 2018-19 to FY 2021-22. SSA provided one or more types of services and assistance to approximately 1 out of every 6 senior residents of the County in June 2019.
