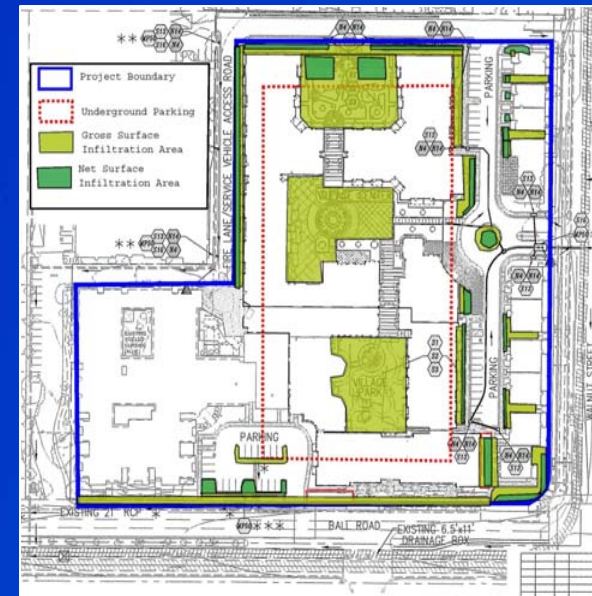

NOC vs. SOC Issues

- All program documents developed to cover both permits
- Majority of documents identical or very similar; distinctions called out where applicable
- MWQMP approved by SARWQCB; SDRWQCB has not commented
