## **Need Proof of Property Tax Payment if Paying Online or by Mailing a Check?**

Treasurer-Tax Collector Shari Freidenrich encourages taxpayers to save the cost of a stamp and pay your property tax bill on-line by eCheck (bank) without any service fee at [ocgov.com/octaxbill](http://ocgov.com/octaxbill), on the County's secure website. Freidenrich states, "This payment option provides for an instant receipt, just as if you were in our office". We hope you will consider joining the hundreds of thousands of taxpayers paying online by eCheck and receiving a receipt for your property tax payment." When taxpayers make property tax payments online, an email receipt is sent within a few minutes of submitting the payment. In addition, our website provides date and amount of payments processed online and also for mailed checks for the current year and the past two years.

To further assist taxpayers, property tax payments processed up until midnight, Tuesday, April 10, 2018, using the Orange County Treasurer-Tax Collector's website at [ocgov.com/octaxbill](http://ocgov.com/octaxbill) will be accepted as timely payment of taxes. When you pay your property tax bill online, the website provides a record of the payment date, amount of payments processed and when the account was credited. A taxpayer receives same-day credit for these payments, can print the payment receipt and also receive a payment receipt by e-mail. If you are paying more than one parcel, use our convenient online "cart" function so that you only have to put in your bank account or credit card information once, and receive a payment receipt listing each of the parcels paid.
