

Flood Control Channel Improvements: Como Channel, Irvine

Project Summary

OC Public Works will perform maintenance and repairs along a section of the Como Flood Control Channel located in Irvine. This work will enhance the channel's flood control effectiveness for the surrounding community.

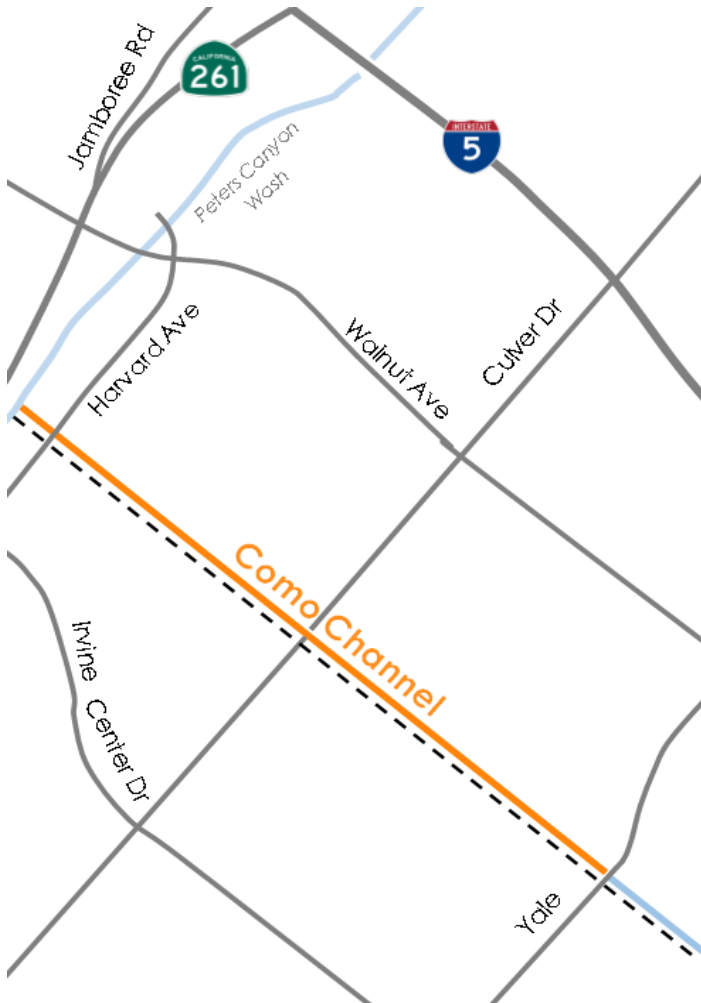


WHAT

Activities will include sediment and debris removal, concrete repairs, re-establishment of existing "rip rap" (large rocks) and backfilling washouts.

Residents adjacent to the channel may experience temporary construction noise and dust. Bike trail adjacent to the channel will be closed during construction. Bicyclists and other trail users will be redirected to a temporary detour along Harvard Avenue and Walnut Avenue.
