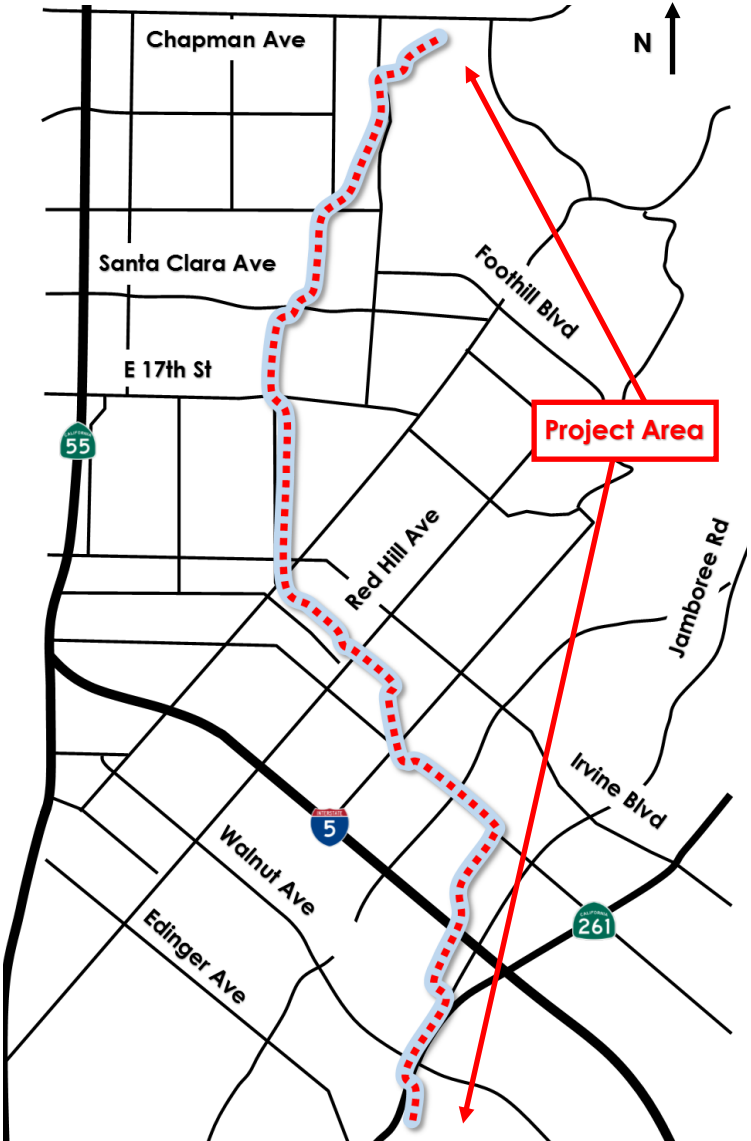


El Modena — Irvine Channel Rehabilitation Project

Project Summary

OC Public Works will complete routine repairs to the El Modena—Irvine Flood Control Channel in the cities of Orange, Tustin, Irvine and unincorporated North Tustin.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Residents who live within close proximity to the flood channel may be impacted by noise and dust during construction. The rehabilitation work will include repairing concrete, restoring sections of earthen slope, removing and replacing “rip-rap,” removing and replacing corroded corrugated metal pipe, installing new drains, and backfilling wash-out areas and walking paths adjacent to the channel.
