



## San Diego Creek Rehabilitation Project



### Project Summary

OC Public Works will begin rehabilitation work along the San Diego Creek flood control channel in the City of Irvine. All construction activity will occur within the flood control channel and adjoining levy; however, **temporary closures to the adjacent bikeway and pedestrian trail for equipment/vehicles entering and exiting will be required during regular working hours.** Traffic control measures, such as flag personnel and signage, will be present.

### WHAT

The rehabilitation work consists of removing sediment, repairing the channel slopes, sealing cracks and other minor maintenance. Businesses and residents located within close proximity to the project area may experience an increase in construction-related, noise, dust and slow-moving construction traffic.

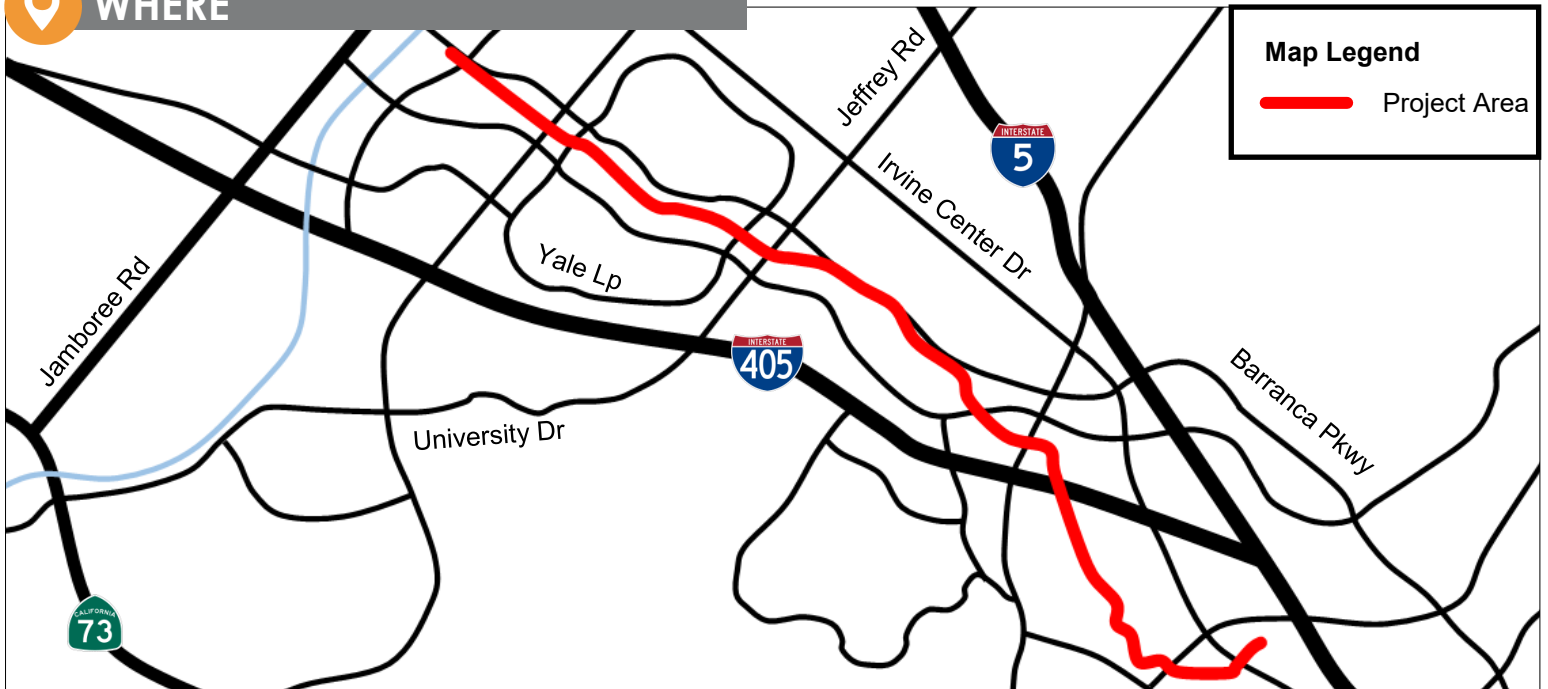
