

COUNTY OF ORANGE REFERENCE LIST FOR PALEONTOLOGIST AND ARCHAEOLOGIST MINIMUM QUALIFICATION

To be considered as a Paleontologist and Archaeologist on the County's the Reference List, the individual must meet the following minimum qualification for their applicable subject area:

1. A qualified Archaeologist must:

- Hold a graduate degree in archaeology, or in anthropology or a closely related field with a specialization in archaeology, plus at least one year professional level experience (surveys, excavations, or other archaeological work pertinent to environmental review requirements), major components for which the individual had principal responsibility.
- or
- Have a BA or BS degree in archaeology, or in anthropology or a closely related field with a specialization in archaeology, plus at least three years professional level experience (surveys, excavations, or other archaeological work pertinent to environmental review requirements), major components for which the individual had principal responsibility.
- or
- Have the membership in professional archeological society such as Register of Professional Archeologists (RPA).
- Have at least one year of local Southern California archaeological experience.
- Have demonstrated ability to carry research studies and reports to completion in a timely manner.

2. A qualified Paleontologist must:

- Hold a graduate degree in paleontology, or in geology or a closely related field with a specialization in paleontology, plus at least one year of profession level experience (surveys, salvage, or other paleontological work pertinent to environmental review requirements), major components for which the individual had principal responsibility.
- or
- Have a BA or BS degree In paleontology or in geology or a closely related field with specialization in paleontology, plus at least three years professional level experience (surveys, salvage, or other paleontological work pertinent to environmental review requirements), major components of which the individual had principal responsibility.
- or

- Have the membership in professional paleontological society such as The Paleontological Society (PS).
- Have at least one year of local Southern California paleontological experience.
- Have demonstrated ability to carry research studies and reports to completion in a timely manner.

Qualifications for listing on the reference list are based on submittal of resume and letter of qualifications. OC Public Works (OCPW)/OC Development Services reviews the submitted documents for compliance with the criteria stated above.
