



Oso Parkway Bridge Project

Project Update: May 29, 2020

All Lanes on Oso Parkway Now Open!

Construction activities, including new connection below the bridge, will continue until October 2020.

i WHAT

Westbound and eastbound lanes along Oso Parkway have reopened to their full configuration.

NOTE: Temporary lane closures will be needed at times to install traffic detection loops along Oso Parkway, install permanent striping and relocate traffic signals at each end of the project area.

Other Remaining Construction Activities:

Construction activities through overall completion in October 2020 include:

- Final preparations of SR-241 and Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Complete overhead signs along SR-241 ramps
- Level utility manhole covers with road surface
- Complete grading slopes along SR-241 and Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Complete concrete drainage ditch along Los Patrones Parkway ramps
- Relocate utility service meter cabinet and traffic signal controller
- Complete miscellaneous electrical work

Intermittent Lane Closures As Needed Over Coming Weeks:

7 am—3 pm, as needed to complete various construction activities

Overall Project Completion:

October 2020
